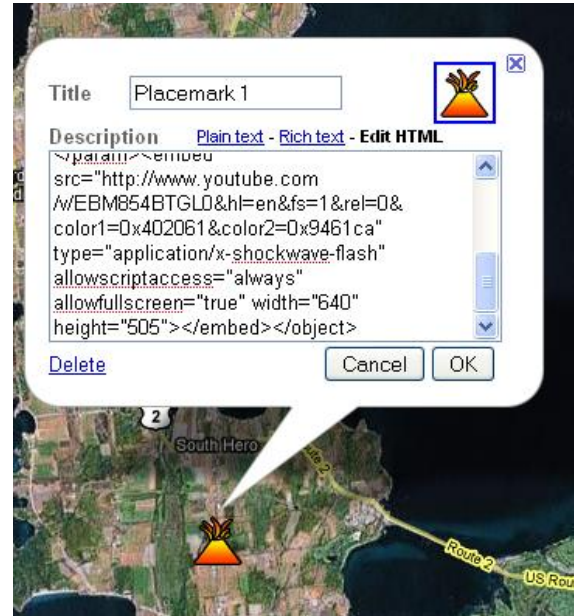
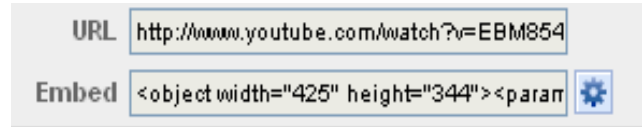


# Adding Video a Map in Google Maps and Google Earth

## 1. In Google Maps

- Locate a video in a site such as YouTube. Copy the snippet of code that allows to embed a video into a Web site or blog.
- Go to Google Maps - <http://maps.google.com/>
- Log in as [cscmaps09@gmail.com](mailto:cscmaps09@gmail.com) with the password [cscmaps09](#)
- Click on "My Maps" and click on "Create a New Map"
- Give your map a title
- Zoom in on Vermont by dragging with the hand tool and double-clicking on Vermont.
- Move a placemark on top an appropriate spot
- Click on the placemark symbol to change it to a different placemark if you wish.
- Give it a title and description.
- Click on the "Edit HTML" link and paste in the embed snippet for the video site.
- Click OK and save. The video should play on top of the map when the placemark is clicked.



## 2. In Google Earth

- Locate a video in a site such as YouTube. Copy the snippet of code that allows to embed a video into a Web site or blog.
- Open Google Earth
- Add a placemark to your map by clicking on the placemark button and then dragging it to the position you want.
- Give the placemark a name
- Paste the snippet from the video site into the description box and click OK.
- When you click on the placemark the video should play above the map.
